Proposition to issue negotiable electric revenue bonds of the City of Jackson, Cape Girardeau County, Missouri, to the amount of Eight Million, Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$8,800,000) to provide funds for the purpose of paying part of the cost of improving and extending the electric light plant owned exclusively by said City; said bonds to be payable, both as to principal and interest, solely from the revenues to be derived by said City from the operation of said plant?

It is hereby certified that the undersigned, RODNEY MILLER, Clerk of the County Court and Election Authority within and for the County of Cape Girardeau, in the State of Missouri, Karen McCullough, from the Democratic Party, and Virginia Perdue, from the Republican Party, acting as the Verification Board for the special bond election held in the City of Jackson, Cape Girardeau County, Missouri, on Tuesday, the 2nd day of June, 1981, at which election there was submitted to the qualified electors of said City the following proposition, to-wit:

"PROPOSITION
