

(3) For instance, the subaccount funds shall be distributed pursuant to (1) and (2) of this subsection in a proportion not less than the racial percentages of the state's total population as established by the latest decennial census conducted by the United States Bureau of the Census.
5. Incentive funding for educational improvement shall be allocated annually by the coordinating board. As provided by the coordinating board, these funds may be allocated in recognition of a community college's or a state institution's improvement in or achievement of education outcomes or on the basis of competitive grant applications to establish pilot projects to improve educational outcomes.
3. The coordinating board for higher education shall be the administrative agency for the implementation of the program established by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.
